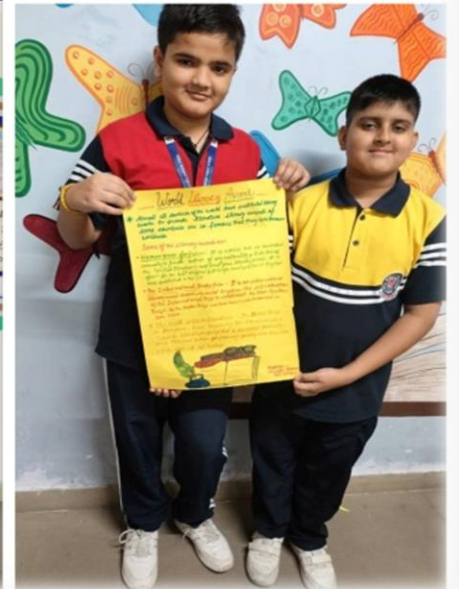
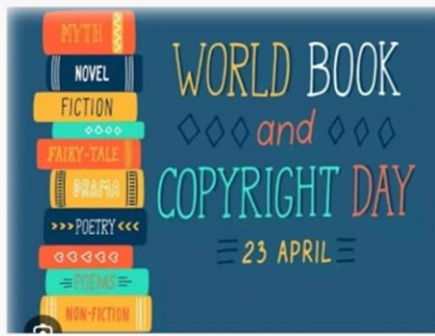
Kindergarten students enjoyed engaging activities, including:

□ Foundational Literacy & Numeracy (FLN) – Focused on strengthening early education

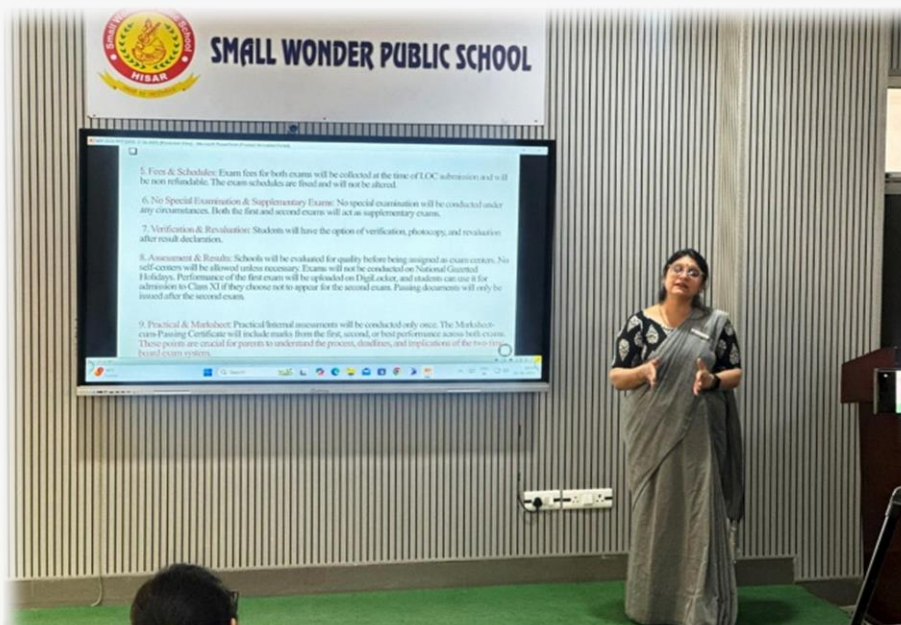
□ Assessment Reforms – Shifted towards competency-based learning

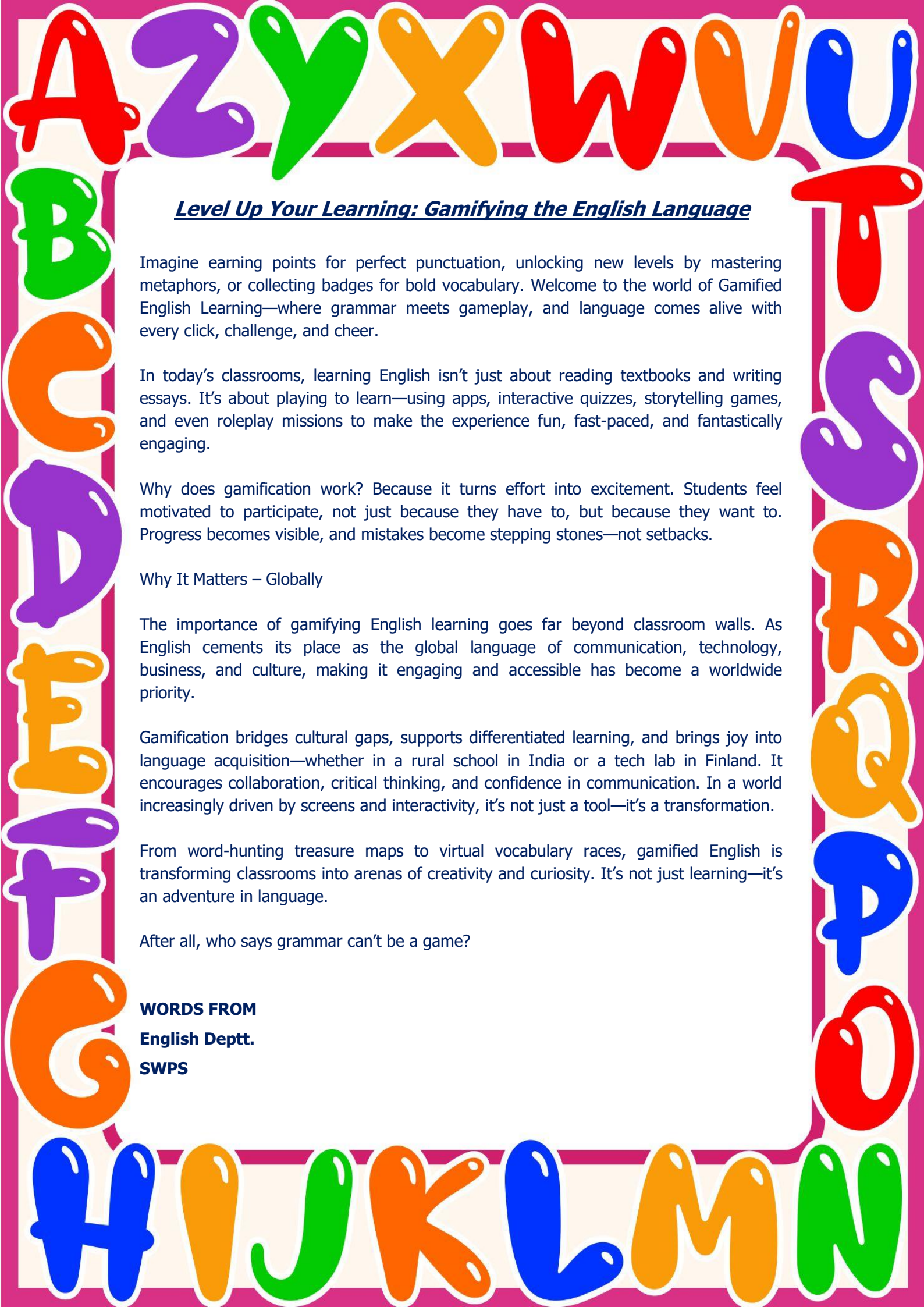

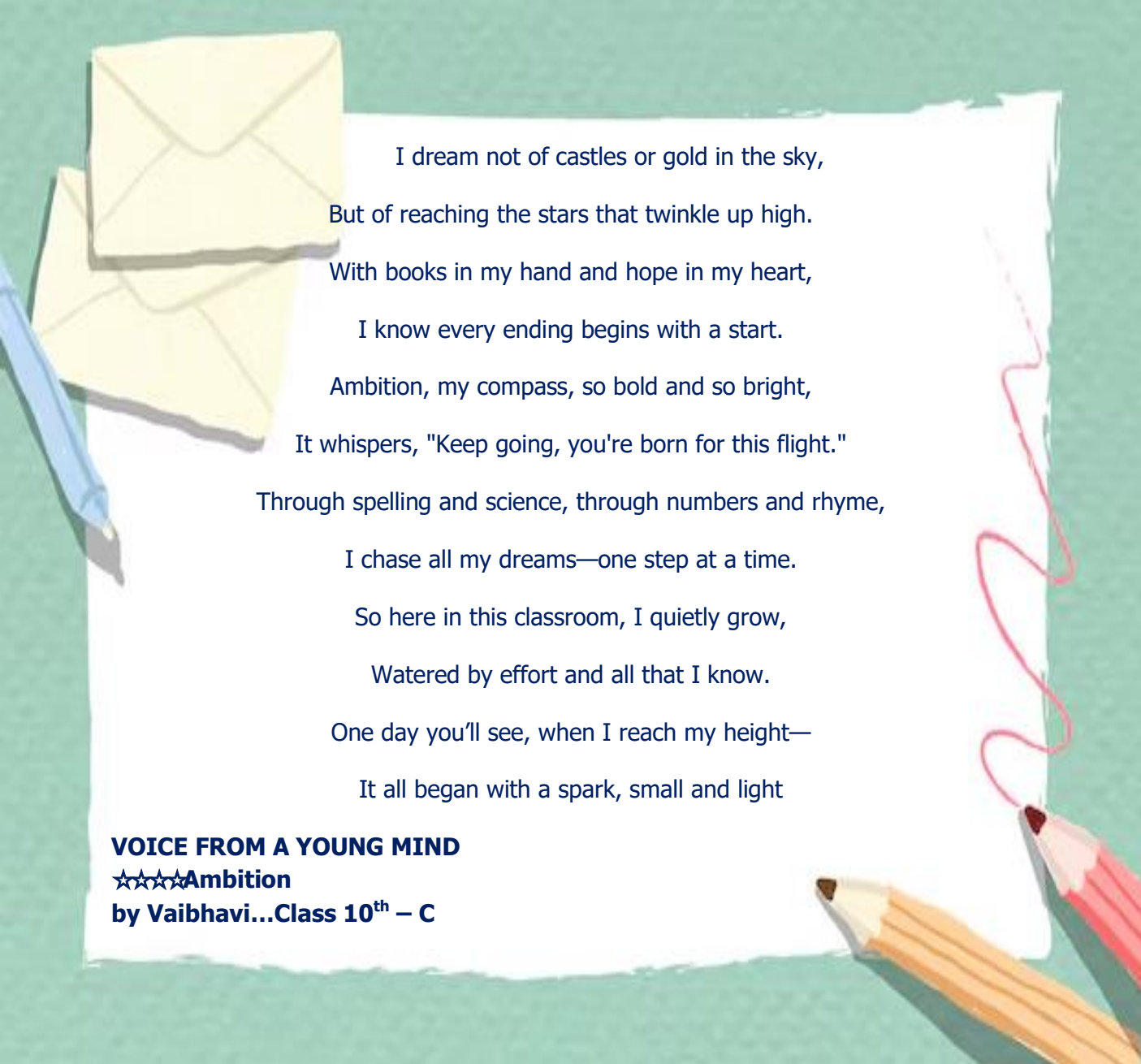

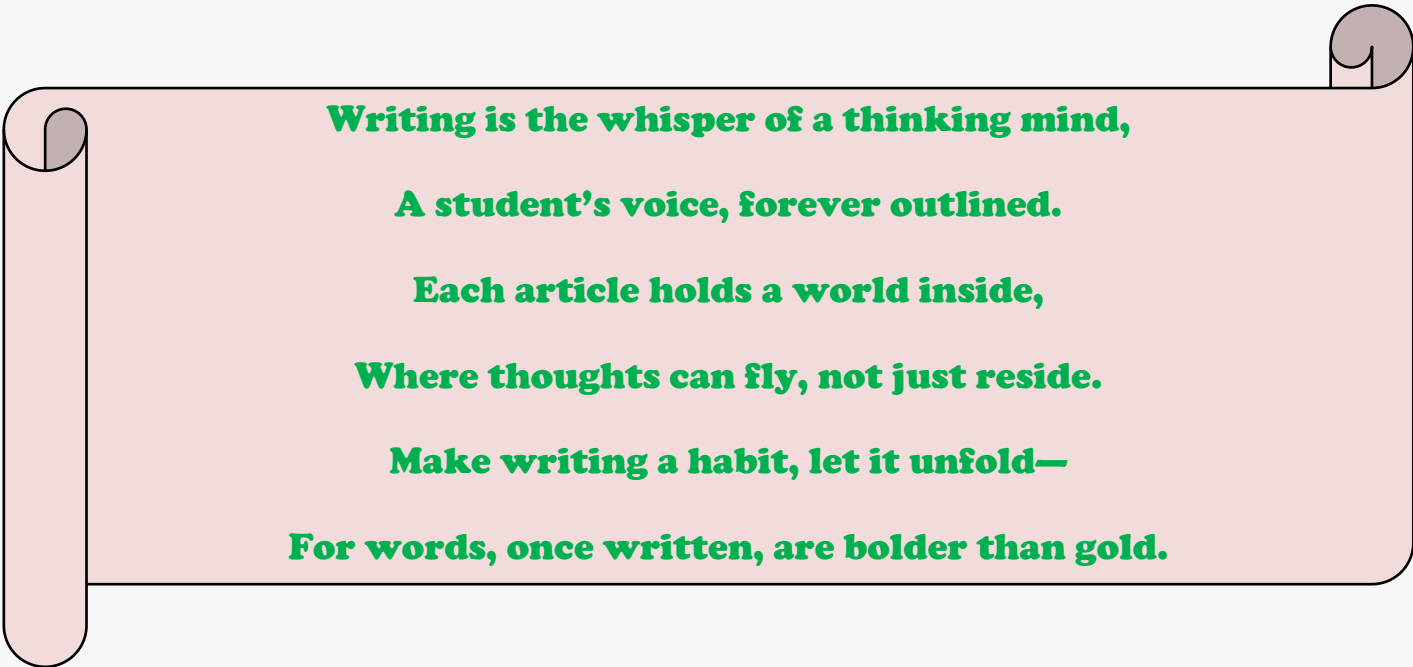
