To further engage everyone in the spirit of Labour Day, games were organized for our support staff. They participated enthusiastically, and the winners of the games were awarded with prizes.

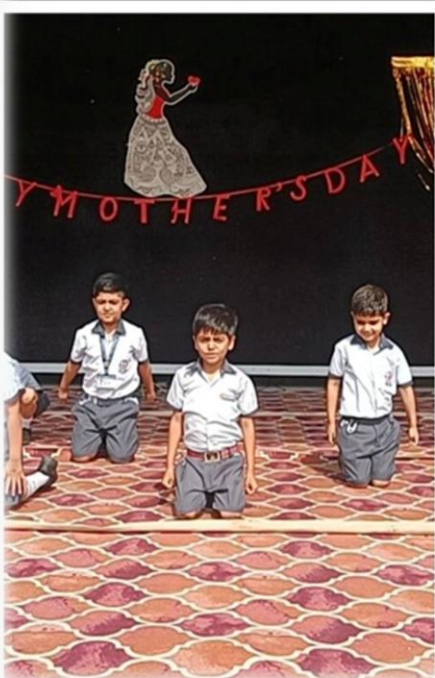


Mother's Day Celebration

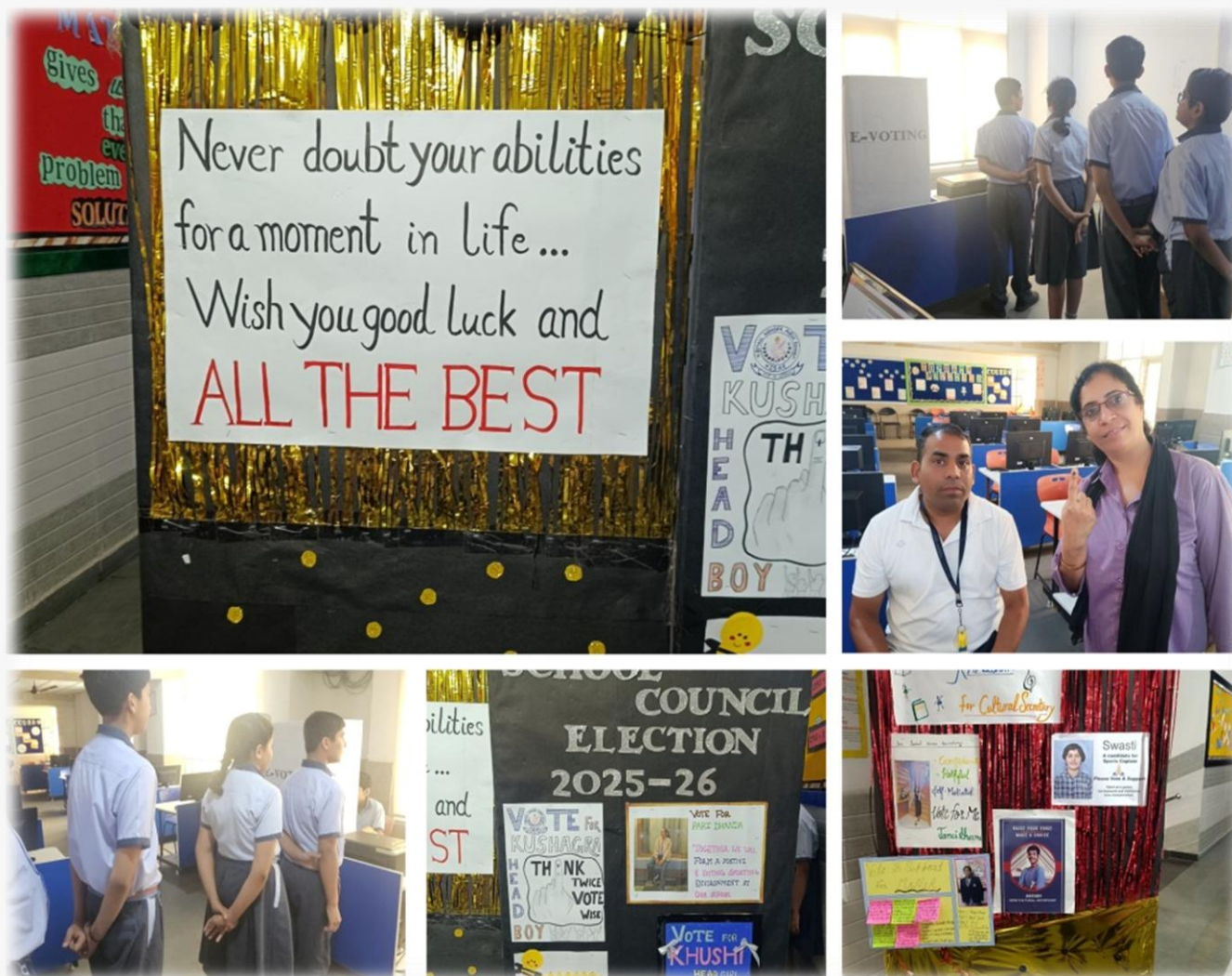


E-Voting for School Council Elections: Empowering Young Leaders Through Digital Democracy

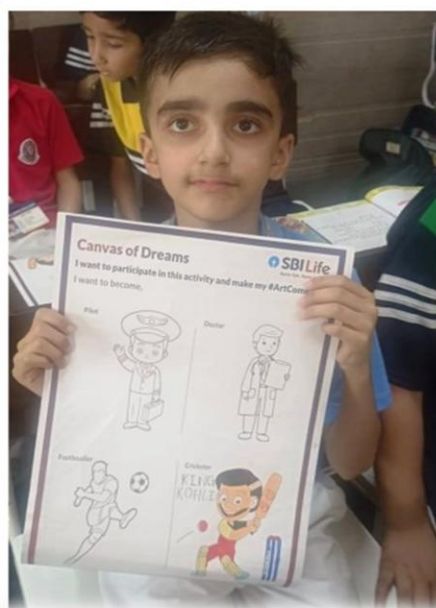
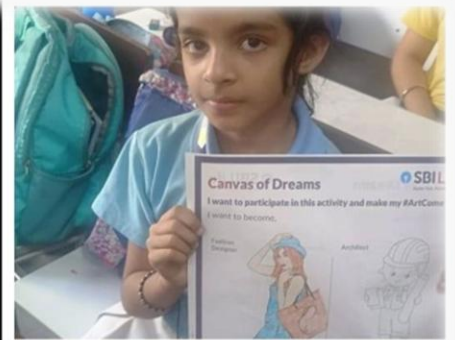
"Hue's for a Secure Tomorrow!"

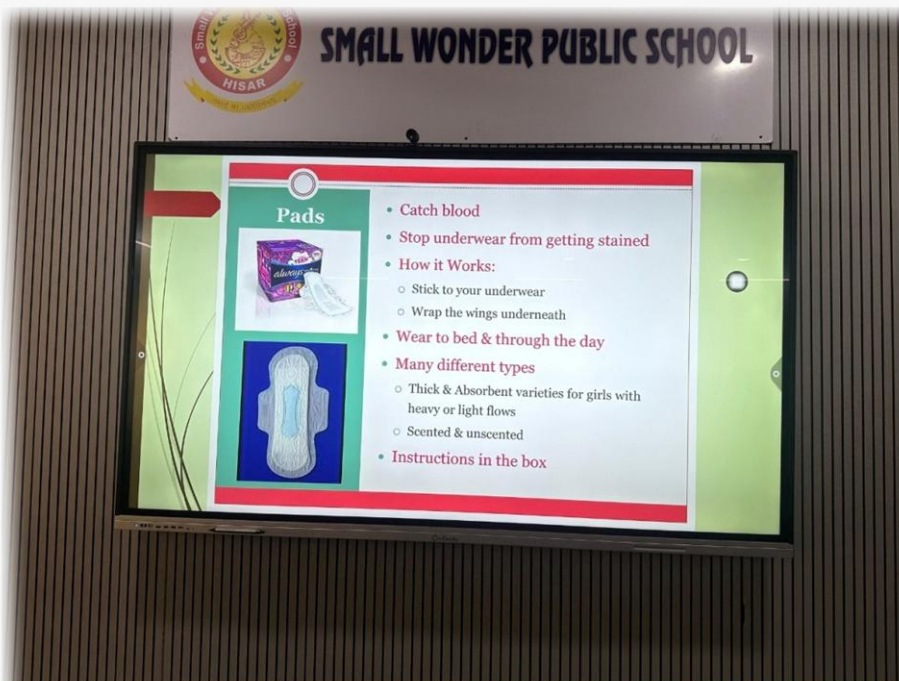
Menstrual Health Session

They learned how to save smartly, spend wisely, and even dream big with a budget. The young minds discovered that money wasn't just about math—it was about mindset.

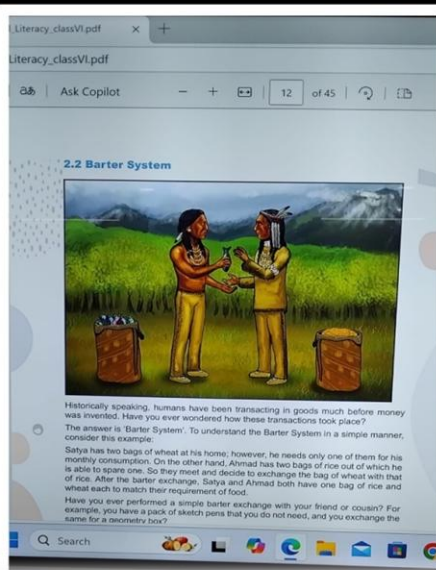
The young explorers  embarked on an exciting journey—not across maps , but through money matters!

We saluted our soldiers for their success in Operation Sindoor.

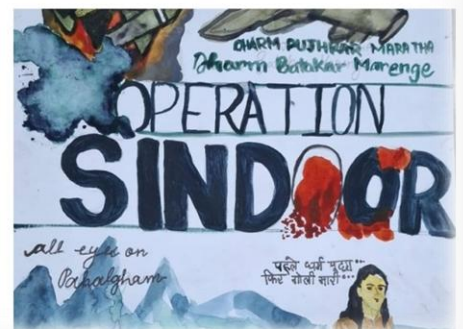
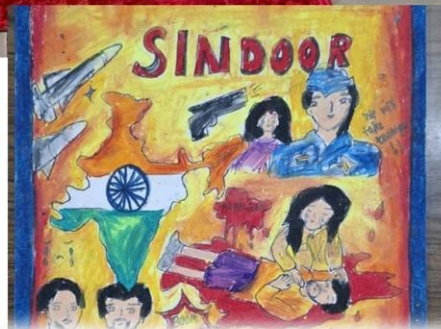
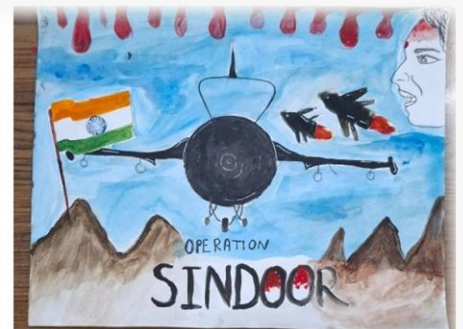
As a part of the ongoing campaign by Dainik Jagran to pay tribute to our brave soldiers, we had organized a series of meaningful activities in school.

☐ **Swimming Fun**

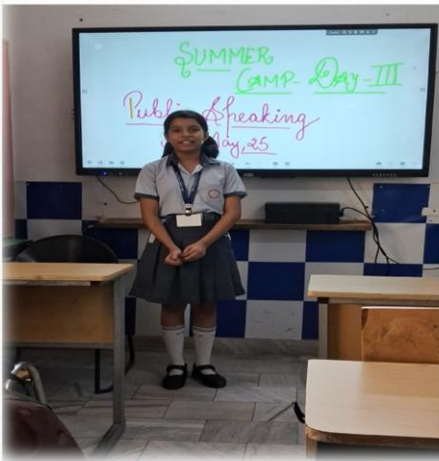
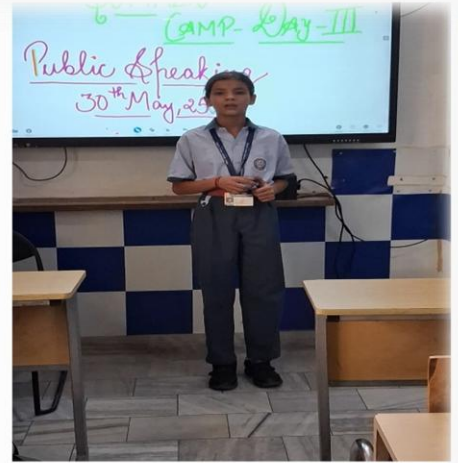
The swimming activity was a hit as the campers cooled off and had a great time enjoying water games under the supervision of our expert coaches.

हिंदी से दूर होते बच्चे – एक चिंताजनक स्थिति पर विचार

हिंदी हमारी मातृभाषा, हमारी संस्कृति और हमारी पहचान की मूल भाषा है। लेकिन आज हम देख रहे हैं कि बच्चे हिंदी से धीरे – धीरे दूर होते जा रहे हैं। स्कूलों, घरों, और समाज में अंग्रेजी के प्रभाव ने हिंदी के प्रयोग को सीमित कर दिया है। यह न केवल भाषा की दृष्टि से, बल्कि सांस्कृतिक और नैतिक मूल्यों के लिहाज से भी चिंता की बात है।

बहुत से शहरी परिवारों में माता-पिता अब बच्चों से अंग्रेजी में ही बात करते हैं, चाहे उनकी मातृभाषा हिंदी ही क्यों न हो। उन्हें लगता है कि इससे बच्चा “स्मार्ट” बनेगा। इसका नतीजा बच्चे हिंदी में ठीक से सोच, बोल या लिख नहीं पाते। उन्हें अपने दादा-दादी या बड़े-बुजुर्गों की बातें समझने में कठिनाई होती है।

प्राइवेट स्कूलों में *Only English* की नीति होती है। हिंदी बोलने पर बच्चों को टोका जाता है, या मजाक बनाया जाता है।

टीवी, यूट्यूब और मोबाइल गेम्स का कंटेंट ज्यादातर अंग्रेजी में होता है। बच्चों के पसंदीदा कार्टून, शोज, और वीडियो हिंदी में बहुत कम उपलब्ध होते हैं या अनुवादित होते हैं।

बच्चे अंग्रेजी भाषा के साथ भावनात्मक रूप से जुड़ जाते हैं।

हिंदी के प्रति उनका झुकाव धीरे-धीरे खत्म होता है।

मातृभाषा की कमजोर समझ से बच्चों की सोचने की क्षमता प्रभावित होती है।

- संस्कृति, साहित्य और मूल्यों से दूरी बन जाती है।

इससे बच्चों के मन में हिंदी को लेकर हीन भावना पैदा होती है।

वे हिंदी को “कमजोरों की भाषा” समझने लगते हैं।

बच्चों को हिंदी से दूर होने देना सिर्फ भाषा को नहीं, बल्कि संस्कारों और पहचान को खोने जैसा है। हमें मिलकर यह प्रयास करना होगा कि अगली पीढ़ी हिंदी में न केवल बोलना, बल्कि सोचना और गर्व करना भी सीखे।

“अगर जड़ें मजबूत होंगी, तभी वृक्ष ऊँचा होगा और हिंदी हमारी सबसे गहरी जड़ है।”
