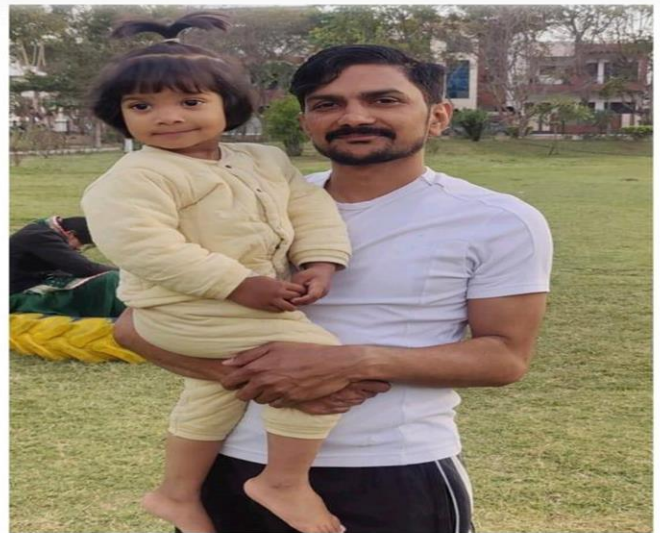
Father's Day

The activity blended gamified learning with conceptual clarity, turning theory into action and competition into collaboration.

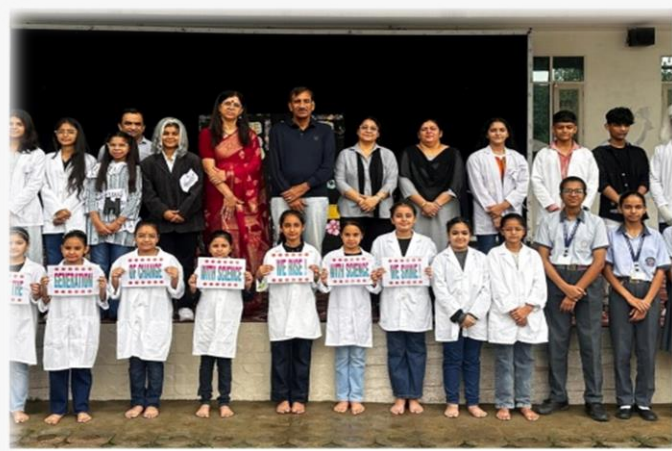
- Kudos to our budding scientists for going beyond the textbook—debating, dramatizing, decoding, and discovering science in innovative ways!

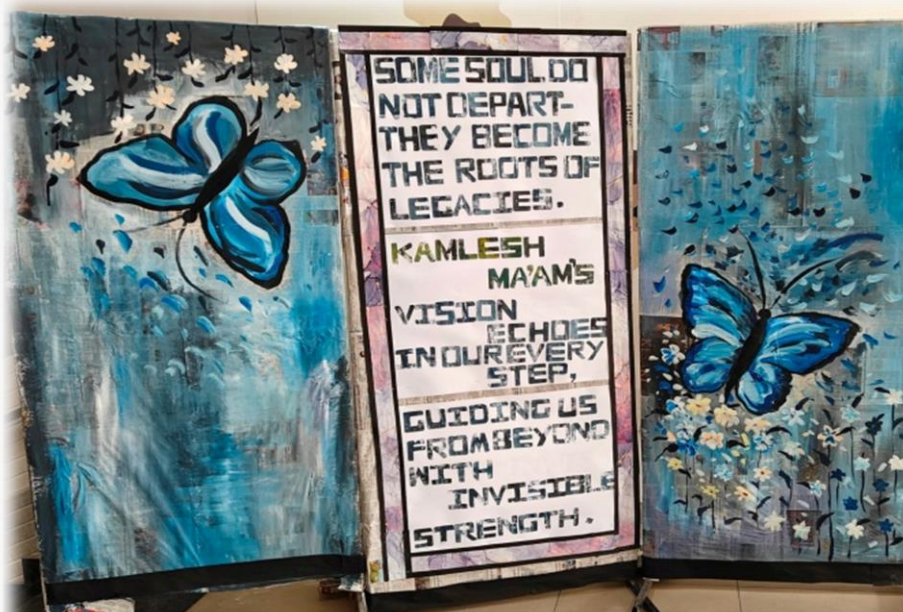

Untraceable Voters: When Aadhaar Meets Electoral Rolls in Bihar

1. What Happened?

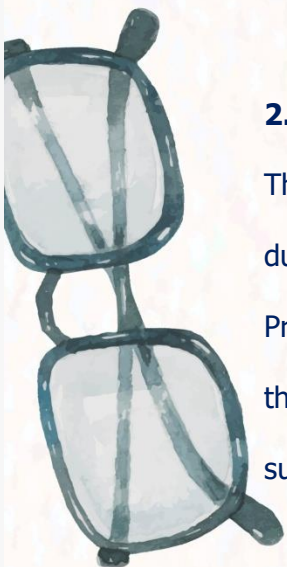
In late July 2025, the Election Commission of India (EC) initiated a Special Intensive Revision (SIR) of electoral rolls in Bihar, primarily to eliminate duplicate, deceased, and ineligible entries.

During this process, about 35 lakh voters were marked as "untraceable", their names flagged or removed because they couldn't be verified in person or digitally. This triggered opposition backlash, with parties alleging disenfranchisement and manipulation of the voter list .

2. Aadhaar Linkage: The Trigger or the Tool?

The process involved linking Aadhaar data with voter IDs to check for duplication and correct demographics.

Previous attempts at such linkage—like in Andhra and Telangana—led to the removal of around 30 lakh voters, prompting the Supreme Court to suspend those efforts. Critics claim the current SIR may reflect similar systemic flaws.





3. Legal and Political Fallout

The controversy has reached the Supreme Court, which is reviewing due process, transparency, and whether fundamental rights have been compromised.

In Parliament, opposition parties have demanded clear justification and remedies for affected individuals, while the EC assures all major political stakeholders were consulted and a window for objections will open on August 1.

4. Real-World Impact on Citizens

Voters who were removed found themselves unable to participate in elections and often unaware of the changes.

Legal recourse is limited: reinstating a voter's name requires filing objections during official revision windows—and many may not know the process in time.



5. Key Questions Going Forward

- i) Were all eligible citizens given fair opportunity to verify or contest their status?
 - ii) How reliable is the underlying Aadhaar database in accurately linking with voter IDs?
 - iii) What safeguards exist to prevent politicization of revision exercises?
 - iv) Can mechanisms be strengthened to prevent mis-deletion of legitimate voters?

Conclusion :-

The Bihar case underscores a central tension: Aadhaar–voter ID linkage may promise administrative cleanliness, but at the risk of mass disenfranchisement if implemented poorly. The removal of 35 lakh names raises alarm about data accuracy, transparency, and legal safeguards.

To ensure such revisions don't undermine trust in democracy, clear policies, public transparency, independent audits, and robust dispute resolution must be prioritized—and voters must themselves be empowered to verify their inclusion.
